

RED ROUTE

PRESTEIGNE - KINNERTON LOOP

(25Km, 15.5miles)

1 Out of WM – turn L. 2 After 250m take rd towards Cascob. Keep on this road – [after half mile by barns on L can see notice for Discoed Church – worth visiting this beautiful church with ancient yews] until you get to cross roads 3 by red telephone box – go straight across towards Cascob. After 2 miles come to stone bridge with green railings & post box. 4 Take bridleway on L which starts on tarmac, continue up hill and off road. Go up and over the hill until you reach the gate at bottom & the road 5 Take L past Ednol Farm. Keep on this for 1.4 miles until Kinnerton & road junction. *** 6 Take road to the left of the church sign posted Evenjobb. Cycle through Evenjobb. At crossroads go straight ahead. After 100m there is an option of keeping on road to Presteigne (bearing R) DO NOT TAKE THIS – instead take 7 a left, past telephone box and post box - go past Upper House and up steep hill. Pass North Hill Wood on the top and descend down into Presteigne. Past School. 8 At end of road take L. (if you carry on here for one mile you will come to WM on L.) At the playground turn R to Knighton. [If you fancy a dip in the Lugg or a stroll round small Nature reserve – stop by allotments.] Continue up Knighton road for 1 mile and turn left opposite the small white house. Along for 1 mile. Until you come to a junction by the postbox u turn left by postbox, continue on the Presteigne rd over stone bridge and back to WM which is on R.

CYCLE ROUTES

DISCOED - PRESTEIGNE LOOP

(14Km, 8.7miles)

- 1 Out of WM turn L round corner over stone bridge.
- 2 Take next R by post box. Keep on lane until come to main road
- 3 Take left then immediately turn R by small white house. Keep on lane till T junction 4 Turn R into Presteigne, over stone bridge past church on R. At mini roundabout take 2nd exit up hill. 5 Take R towards Knighton. 6 Take 2nd L up road labled Warden Rd then 7 Next R up road (again labled Warden Rd). Keep on lane uphill for 1 mile. Through 3 gates amazing views. After 3rd gate keep straight & go down hill. 8 Turn 1st R, down steep hill. At bottom of hill ** 9 Turn R, keep going until junction by stone bridge take R & WM is just up rd on the R.
- ** if you look to your left you will see notice for church up there find beautiful St Michaels church and one of the 5 oldest yews in the British Isles.

*** Short cut for Red Route (via Whimble Nursery)

If you fancy visiting Whimble Nursery & tea shop (open Easter – autumn)

6 Turn L towards Knighton. After 0.5 the nursery is on the R. Continue on this road until come to Beggars Bush. 7 At cross roads take L towards Presteigne & Knighton. Downhill 8 Take R to Discoed. (As come into Discoed the church with beautiful ancient yews is up on R.) Continue on this rd until junction 2 Take R by stone bridge & WM is on the R.
